

Facility Use Fees

SMALL GROUPS (40 or fewer):

Per person group rate is \$3. (min. 8 ppl)
This does NOT include set up. \$75 minimum when museum is closed to the public.

OPEN HOUSE STYLE:

\$150 for up to 3 hours of use.*
Client is responsible for set up.
(Museum staff may be hired to set up, additional \$100 fee is required)

LUNCHEONS, MEETINGS, BANQUETS, RECEPTION S for more than 40 guests, not exceeding 3 hours*:

During hours while museum is open to the public; \$3 per person or \$250, whichever is LESS, based on number of people set up for.

Private event while museum is closed to the public*; \$3 per person, based on number of people set up for (\$150 minimum)..

***Additional hours** of use (exceeding 3) will be charged at \$50 per hour before 4pm weekdays and \$100 per hour after 4pm weekdays or anytime Saturday or Sunday.

Per Person Fees are based on seating count and are due ten days prior to event.

A non-refundable deposit of \$50 will hold your date.

All rates are subject to change without notice prior to signing contract.

Discounted rates may be available for Coopersville Farm Museum Members. Request information regarding membership.

Group Tours during Regular Business Hours: \$3 per person. Student rate is \$2 per person. Driver and coordinator of tour receives free admission with groups of 8 or more.

Museum Hours are Tuesday through Saturday, 10am - 4pm from July through September. Winter Hours are: Tuesday, Thursday, & Saturday, 10am - 2pm, from October through June.

Also open for groups of 8 or more with reservation, for private events, & for special events.
